This fall edition is dedicated to the wonderful sweet and warm aromas of comforting fall desserts and drinks. NO perfume-y blends, florals or musky fragrances of any kind in this edition!, just pure decadent sweetness. Although every blend can be used in any way you desire, this time the blends were specially designed for soap, so you can give your traditional Goat milk, Oatmeal, milk and Honey or Pumpkin soap a festive tweak with this bunch of sweet fall decadent blends. Enjoy!!!...

Blueberry Muffins & Spiced Honey

2 parts OT Chai Tea
2 parts OT Wild Huckleberry Honey
1 part OT Buzzy Bumble Buttermilk Bath

You'll feel the tiny blueberry seeds in your mouth when you smell this yummy blend reminiscent of hot freshly baked buttermilk blueberry muffins with just a touch of spicy honey. Imagine a purple swirled buttermilk or goat milk soap scented with this blend!, What about some blueberry seeds added to the purple soap base used for the swirl?. A bit of honey added to the soap would be great too...Yum!!!

Persimmon Spice Cake

1 part OT PersimmonBerry
1 part OT Frosted Lemon Pound Cake
1 part OT Chai Tea

Another blend worth trying it!. I tweaked Oregon Trail's new Lemon Poundcake with the sparkling berry fusion of Persimmonberry and the spicy creamy Chai Tea to develop this exotic spicy fruit cake blend. Each component in the blend really seems to be made for each other. This blend also calls to be made in a goat milk soap!. What about some deep orange swirls in it!

Caramelized Peach Custard

3 parts OT Vanilla Cream
2 parts OT White Butterfly
1 part OT Peche de Vigne

Creamy smooth vanilla blends with sweet caramel and soft fresh peach notes in this indulgent blend of creamy custard like notes. Pure creamy heaven!.

Pumpkin Praline Fudge

2 part OT Ol' South Pumpkin Pie
1 part OT Toasted Marshmallows & Hot Cocoa
1 part OT White Butterfly

Spicy pumpkin blends with smooth creamy notes of chocolate and marshmallow and touched with the sweet caramel praline like notes of Oregon Trail's White butterfly fragrance to create the perfect unusual fudge like fragrance for this fall season!. Give your pumpkin puree soaps a new twist with this delicious fragrance.

Punkin' Spice Latté

1 part OT Capuccino de la Avellana
1 part OT Ol' South Pumpkin Pie

I would never imagine this simple blend of two fragrances could smell so rich and realistic!. It just can't wait to get the ingredients to make an actual Pumpkin Spice Latté as I want to try one really bad after making this blend. Have you ever made goat milk soap with some canned Pumpkin added too?. I've never tried it before but this blend really makes me want to play mad soaping scientist too.

Gyngerbrede

5 parts OT Buzzy Bumble
2 parts OT Chai Tea
2 parts OT Ginger Spice

Yet another perfect example of how completely different fragrance fuse to create a whole different fragrance. This time this concoction smells just like...you guessed it...Gingerbread!. Try it and see!. I designed this blend to discolor only a baked gingerbread brown in soap. Some ground cinnamon and ginger as well as finely pulverized oats would add some interest to a soap scented with this fragrance. Have you got some gingerbread man soap molds?

Nutty Chocolate Coffee Brownies

5 parts OT Chocolate Truffles
3 parts OT Chai Tea
3 parts OT Capuccino de la Avellana
1 part OT Amande Amere

Chocolate lovers, here's a blend that will surely awake your chocolate craving!. The rich chocolate scent of Oregon Trails "Chocolate Truffles" melts with creamy spices and delightful coffee. A hint on almonds and hazelnut adds a warm nutty character to this blend that smells like fresh oven baked chocolate and coffee brownies. This blend would make great scent for chocolate theme soaps. What about a layered soap with different brown shades and components?, adding some melted unsweetened baking chocolate to the batch?, pulverized hazelnuts and almonds?. Some light colored soap bits embedded in a dark brown soap looks very nice too!. Let your imagination go with this decadent chocolate blend.

Fall Pomeberry Sangria

2 parts OT Cabernet Sauvignon
1 part OT Pomegranate
1 part OT PersimmonBerry

Just as exotic smelling as its name. Robust wine notes joins juicy pomegranate and exotic berries in this intense fruity blend that that will truly make your mouth water. It's a blend with a lot of character and I'm sure you'll want to use it all year round. What about a wine soap scented with this fragrance?. I'm sure it will be a hit among wine and sangria lovers and it's the perfect scent for a matching lotion or body butter too.

Fragrance Highlights:

Be sure to check these wonderful new OT fragrances!

Wild Huckleberry Honey: Incredibly realistic Huckleberry/Blueberry fragrance!. No bubblegum here. The honey notes just give depth to the fragrance without distracting from the rich juicy blueberry notes. Soaps and holds wonderfully in CP soap.

Frosted Lemon Pound cake: This fragrance smells just like a freshly baked lemony cake!. Nice richly bake cake notes blended with juicy lemony notes. Soaps like a dream and stays absolutely true in soap. It discolors only a light creamy yellow.

Persimmonberry: When I smelled this fragrance I know it will be one of my top favorite fruity fragrances. The depth and fruity complex of this fragrance is really amazing. Lots of bright sparkling "orange" fruit notes. It soaps white with absolutely no problems and each and every note of the oil stays true and strong in CP. This fragrance has a very nice affinity to goat milk based soap.

Capuccino de la Avellana: After trying OT's Columbian Coffee I thought I found the absolute "Holy grail" of coffee fragrance oils, but Oregon Trail did it again. This fragrance is pure rich creamy coffee with nice nutty hints. Smells like having a cup of hot smooth cappuccino. Amazing!.
