There are no strict concepts here, just some blends I really enjoyed making. From amazing old favorites and yummy coffee blends to spectacular new upscale smelling compositions. You'll find in this edition a bunch of fun blends that can be used not just during summer, but any time of the year as well. Let's have some blending fun!...Enjoy!

Island Rose Garden

2 parts OT [Damascus Rose FO](#)

1 part OT [Hibiscus](#)

Roses with a tropical twist, this is a reinvented blend previously named "Island Rose" that I made a couple of years ago using my favorite expensive rose fragrance at that moment, but now with Oregon Trail's new Damascus Rose, the awesome scent of the original blend further improved (and I thought it impossible) due to OT's Damascus Rose complex fragrance. I'm sure you'll fall in love with this bright summery rose fragrance, even if you don't care for roses. It's a sparkling modern rose fragrance that recalls an heirloom sunny island rose garden full of highly fragrant antique roses of every color, wafting their delicate fragrance into the air, while the soft breeze mixes it with the sweet fragrance of exotic blooming tropical flowers nearby. It's truly "out of this world". This scent sticks wonderful in CP soap and it's perfect for lotions or any other scented product. It's destined to be your new bestseller.

"Amaretto Coffee Cream"

5 parts OT [Coffee Bean *Juan Valdez Type*](#)

3 parts OT [Rich Vanilla Creme](#)

3 parts OT [Amaretto Royale](#)

You'll be heading for a Cappuccino when you sniff this blend. The incredibly realistic fresh brewed coffee fragrance of Oregon Trail's Coffee Bean is blended with rich vanilla and cream and hints of almondy Amaretto. It smells very realistic. Note: Have fun creating your own Coffee "recipe" with OT's Coffee!. You use just plain Almond for a nice "Almond Coffee Cream" instead of "Amaretto Royale", but you may possibly want to decrease the amount of oil used for Almond as it's stronger than Amaretto.

"Mocha Mint"

5 parts OT [Coffee Bean *Juan Valdez Type*](#)

3 parts OT [Chocolate truffle](#)

2 parts OT [Rich Vanilla Creme](#)

2 parts OT [Peppermint Ice](#)

Don't put your Coffee fragrance bottle in your shelf yet!. I was a bit reluctant about adding mint to a Mocha fragrance at first, but for my surprise the resulting blend was very nice.

Smells just like a robust Mocha flavored with refreshing mint. Feel free to increase or decrease the amount of mint or any other fragrance to suit your taste. Note: try using Mango, Raspberry, Spices or any other edible fragrance you could think with Coffee!. You can't go wrong.

"Sweet Nag Champa"

2 parts OT [Nag Champa](#)

1 parts OT [Sweet Innocence](#)

Don't know if all you Nag Champa lovers think the same, but I find the original Nag Champa soap fragrance slightly different than how it smells in incense or in any other of their products. To me its soap smells less earthy, with nice clean powdery notes. In an effort to duplicate those nice powdery notes of the soap, I blended Oregon Trail's dead on dupe Nag Champa fragrance with the soft powdery notes of Sweet Innocence with great results. I've tried many different powdery fragrances before with mixed results. Only OT's sweet Innocence added just the notes I wanted. Try it, you'll love this blend.

"Southern Summer"

1 part OT [Brown Sugar & Fig "BBW Type"](#)

1 parts OT [Mardi Gras](#)

1 parts OT [Country Cantaloupe](#)

This extremely upscale smelling fruity blend is easily in my top five favorite blends. If you are looking for a unique fragrance for your summer line of products that would smell like those expensive spa or boutique fragrances in the market, then you need to give this blend a try. It's a bursting carnival of the juiciest fruit nectars and delicate balanced florals with a sexy warm amber background. I tried it in 100% soy wax candles and its cold throw is amazing at 1 oz. per pound of wax. Simple words can't describe how wonderful this blend

is.

Fragrance Highlights:

Here are three great new fragrances from Oregon Trail Soap Supplies:

[Coffee Bean "Juan Valdez Type"](#): This is the holy grail of coffee fragrances!. It's a super strong and very realistic fresh brewed coffee fragrance that works fantastic in cold process soap, unlike many coffee fragrance oils that fade to nothing in soap. I received a soap tester of this fragrance that was many months old and its fragrance was great and discolored a nice coffee and cream color. It works great when blended with vanilla, chocolate or other edible fragrances for an infinite variety of combinations as seen in this edition.

[Damascus Rose](#) - This new Rose fragrance from Oregon Trail is AMAZING!...It smells like it would cost \$1000.00 a pound, just like a fresh dewy Damask Rose! And the best of all is that each and every wonderful note of the FO stays in CP and super glued. You'll be amazed when you sniff this Rose.

[Brown Sugar & Fig "BBW type"](#): This fragrance really surprised me. I've never smelled the original version before and I was expecting too much sweetness that I can stand, but NOT. It's wonderful!. It's a gorgeous modern gourmand fragrance in the vein of Britney Spears fragrances. The Sugar, fig and other sweet notes are there but toned down with a wonderful sexy Amber and floral heart. It's EXTREMELY sexy.
